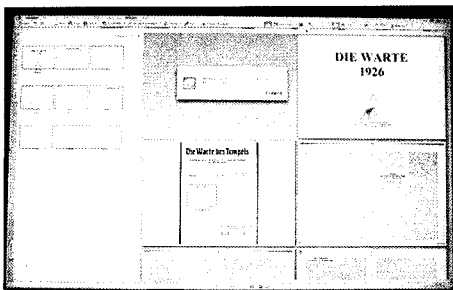

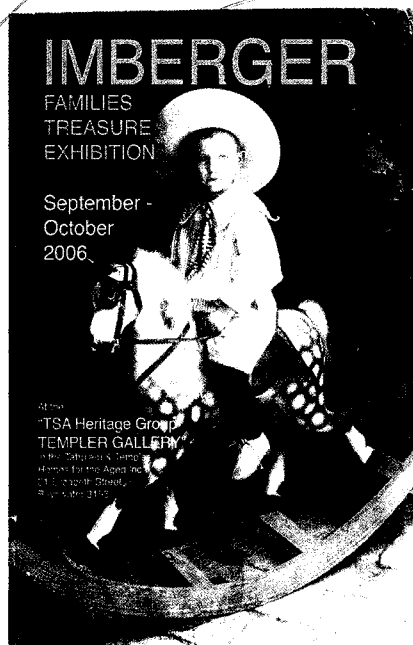
Heritage Room in Bayswater discussion
